- Difference between “Pipeline” and “Active”
- Project Objectives:
 - Agriculture Information System: Adoption of Climate Smart Agriculture (CSA) techniques in old established lands in 3 Governorates (Menoufia, Sharquia and Gharbia)
 - Early warning services: increasing preparedness to climate related shocks

Agriculture Information System: Adoption of Climate Smart Agriculture (CSA) techniques (Menoufia, Sharkia and Gharbia)

- Climate-smart practices at farm level and improving access to markets, reducing losses and adding value beyond farm level
- All farmers below about 10 feddan in the three Governorates will be eligible for financial support for CSA adoption
- Improvement of the irrigation system through **demand-driven process** in the following administrations:
 - Menoufia: Alshuhada' and Ashmoun administrations
 - Sharquia: Al-Husseiniya administration (along El Bagouriya canal)
 - Gharbia: Zifta administration (along the Mowes canal)

Early warning services: increasing preparedness to climate related shocks

- Agro-climate stations of small size will be installed on state-owned land
- Building adaptive capacity at the national level by increasing preparedness to climate related shocks
- Early warning systems: creating an integrated information system and decision support tool
- Training to stakeholder
- Fostering partnerships between insurance companies, financial institutions and agricultural stakeholders
